All students with a catalog year of 2019-20 or later must fulfill this graduation requirement. That includes newly admitted students as well as some current students, such as those who have changed their school or college, or their catalog year. To satisfy this requirement, students will be required to pass at least one three-credit Environmental Literacy course. These courses can be identified by the letter E in the course number.
